The girls from Lilydale – Karen Morgan, Jan O'Regan and Vicki Smith – were successful in the Triples event over the composite team of Pam Arnot, Sandy Elliott and Vicki Hudson.

The girls from Lilydale have blitzed the Region Championships this season winning the Open Fours (with Jessica Wallace), the Open Pairs (Jan O'Regan and Vicki Smith) and the Open Triples. State Champions week will be particularly busy for these ladies.

In the Men's Open Singles, spectators witnessed a sensational final between Norm Whitehead (Heathmont) and Zac Woning (Mitcham). Locked at 24-all, Norm Whitehead played a conversion shot with his last bowl that won the event, sending a message to the Region Selectors that he is not finished with competition bowls just yet. Norm was awarded the John Snell Memorial Trophy for his efforts adding to the silverware he won in the Men's Over 60s Singles event in 2020.

Upcoming Region Championship events to be played in January include the Novice, Men's Open Triples and the



LAWS & UMPIRING

Just prior to the Christmas break, the ERBR Laws and Umpiring Committee was able to successfully **reaccredit** eight officials (thanks to Rodney Bates and yours truly for getting these officials completed in the final weeks of December).

Plans are underway to do on-green testing for approximately 10 **new** officials in the last or second last week of January after these candidates have completed the online modules for measuring, marking and umpiring as appropriate. Further details to follow for candidates to complete their accreditation process.

Further reaccreditation sessions will be scheduled for February and March to address the significant backlog in reaccrediting officials off the back of the COVID period. The one-year extension to lapsing dates for all officials has now passed and the LUC will be looking to get as many as possible updated before the end of the 2023/24 season.

All officials needing to reaccredit will need to follow the new Bowls Victoria process and register their interest in reaccrediting via the BV website (under Officiating). They will then be sent the exam paper and on-green testing will be organised.

All aspiring new officials will also need to visit the BV website and submit their application to become an official. They will then be notified of the process that follows

then be notified of the process that follows regarding face to face and online learning sessions and on-green testing.

Great to field a selection of queries from some of our recently newly accredited officials in the last few weeks – and most importantly, to listen to their logic in methodically explaining the way they handled each situation and appropriately and successfully resolved each to the satisfaction of all parties and in line with the laws of the sport of bowls. WHAT ARE OUR CLUBS DOING?

Ferntree Gully, Upwey-Tecoma & Mulgrave do Jack Attack



Bowls Australia has a great summary of Jack Attack on their website. In summary:

It's intended to be run as a four to eight week competition, staged ideally on a midweek evening, but clubs are free to schedule games any time that suits their club and audiences.

Jack Attack is super easy to play. It's three players per team (known as triples), each with two bowls, who play two sets of five ends, and if the sets are split then a one-end tie-breaker is played to determine a winner – and it's all over in less than 75 minutes!

Ferntree Gully bowlers have just finished a season of Jack Attack for 2023.

A huge 26 teams were bowling through Nov/Dec including through some questionable weather. And they plan to do it all again in 2024.

Upwey-Tecoma is starting an 8-week season of Jack Attack from 24th January. Entries in by 17th January. **Mulgrave Country Club** is starting their Jack Attack season on 14th February
