FROM THE PRESIDENT

And so, another Pennant season has come and gone. 14-week seasons are far too short. However, given the calendar is jam packed with a plethora of events and tournaments, returning to an 18-week season plus finals will not be possible for some time.

I trust that the season saw personal and Club goals and aspirations achieved. Perhaps the off-season may be an opportunity to focus on self-improvement if personal goals were not achieved.

Congratulations also to those Clubs who made finals and were successful in gaining promotion to a higher-grade next season. And to those Clubs and volunteers who hosted finals matches, thank you for showcasing the Region's facilities.

The Eastern Ranges Night Pennant competition has also concluded. A 10-week season comprising 12 teams played in two Sections. In a hard-fought match, section winners Lilydale and Mitcham 3 played in the final, with Lilydale gaining the advantage and taking the title for this season. A big thank you to those Clubs who have supported this competition and to Garry Pickering who gives his time as the sole manager for this event.

Bowls Victoria are considering a more formal night competition for next season. In which case this event may have run its course in the current format. Further information will be provided at a Club Delegates meeting later this month.

The Over 60's Pairs Championship has concluded. While this event is no longer a pathway to State Championships Week, it is important that the Region supports those who are not able to attend the Over 60's Carnival.

In the Women's event, the composite team of Lyn Cameron and Sandy Elliott was successful over Monbulk's Gordana Baric and Irma Turner.

In the Men's event, the Burwood District team of Daryl Contessotto and Tony Villani was successful over the composite team of Colin Veenendaal and Neville Brown.

The Mixed Pairs event has also been 'run and won'. In a close match, the Glen Waverley team of Champay Oram and Rod Petersen was successful over the Lilydale team of Olivia Slade and Josh Sanders.

Entries for the Over 60's Singles Championship close on 24 March 2024.

The final Championship event for the season will be the Champion of Champions commencing 16 March 2024.

In other news, Eastern Ranges representatives Kirsten Day (Yarra Glen), Olivia Slade (Lilydale) and Jessica Wallace (Lilydale) have been selected to play in BV's Women's City squad. The City versus Country Series will see players compete in three Tests over the weekend of 6th and 7th April 2024 at Bendigo East Bowling Club.

A Region Club Delegates meeting is scheduled for 20 March 2024. This meeting will be held electronically. There are several strategic decisions to be determined at this meeting, so it is important that all Clubs are represented.

For those not heading away during the off-season, there is plenty of opportunity to continue with competitive bowls. Events such as the Victorian Open, the over 60s carnival, the Australian Open, the Australian Indoor Championship, the BPL Cup and other quality Club tournaments, allows one to play all year round.

And if you are heading heading off to warmer climates during the off season, safe travels and enjoy the break.

NIGHT PENNANT



The Night Pennant competition has concluded for another year, over the last three weeks the finals have progressed as follows:

The Tuesday qualification finals were played across both Mitcham and Blackburn bowls clubs on the 20th February:

Mitcham 1 defeated Upwey-Tecoma by 22 shots (89-67)

Lilydale defeated Mitcham 2 by 18 shots (85-67)

Mitcham 3 defeated Ferntree Gully by 29 shots (86-57)

Blackburn defeated Mooroolbark by 36 shots (92-56)

The semi-finals were played at Burwood District Bowls Club on the 27 February:

Lilydale defeated Mitcham 1 by 7 shots (75-68)

Mitcham 3 defeated Blackburn 1 by 3 shots (67-64)

The final was played at Mitcham Bowls Club on Tuesday 5 March 2024.

Lilydale defeated Mitcham 3 by 9 shots (78-69). Well done to both teams for a great game.

Bowls Victoria conducted a successful trial with the Metro West Region's Night Pennant this season. This will be expanded to include Eastern Ranges Night Pennant in the 24/25 season.

Changes to the night pennant competition in the 24/25 season will be:

Bowls Victoria would take over the administration of the competition and provide support across various aspects, including competition creation, managing entries, and club training), assistance in developing Conditions of Play, and effective promotion through the Bowlslink portal.

Regions would continue to handle fee collection for the event and retain responsibility for decisions about which evening of play and format.

Bowls Victoria would organise a Finals Series between the Region winners (potentially across multiple grades) at a central venue, with the format determined by BV.

A survey will be conducted to seek feedback on the competition and any improvements that could be made. This will be to existing clubs asking for ideas on how the competition could be improved and to the remaining Eastern Region clubs to see the level of interest in joining the Bowls Victoria run competition.

A TRIBUTE TO HEALESVILLE'S LEGEND: BERYL AYRES

This is a summary of Beryl's achievements as presented by Ian Milgate at the opening of the Beryl Ayres Pavilion in October 2023.

BERYL AYRES PAVILION

A Lifetime of Achievements

Who in their lifetime can say that they have won 90 Championships over 45 years in their chosen sport. I would say only a Legend and that legend is Beryl Ayres from the Healesville Bowling Club. Beryl's first Championship was in 1971 and her last Championship only a few years ago in 2020. It is difficult to comprehend, so I will outline Beryl's achievements.

2005 State Title Championships Zone Winner

1992 State Title Championships (Last 8 in the Country Section)

At a club Level Beryl was invincible winning year after year and becoming a Life Member in 1996. Her Club Championships included-

Ladies Club Handicap Champion Pairs 2019 -2020

Ladies Champion of Champions 8 times between 1978-2007

Ladies State Singles Champion 7 times between 1981 -2006

Ladies Club Champion Singles 31 times between 1971 -2015

Ladies Club Champion Pairs 12 times between 1992-2015

Ladies Club Handicap Champion Singles 16 times between 1974- 2000

Ladies State Pairs Champion 3 times between 1995 -2003

Ladies MV Singles Champion 4 times between 1997-2007

Ladies MV Pairs Champion 4 times between 1974 -1994

As well as this remarkable achievement Beryl also won several Golf and Tennis Championships, and if you think that is incredible, during her younger years Beryl pulled on a football jumper when Women's football was unheard of.

I could not think of a more deserving person to be honoured and remembered as the greatest Lawn Bowler that has played for the Healesville Bowling Club, and the name Beryl Ayres will be remembered forever, as our newly renovated Pa-



vilion is named after her. "The Beryl Ayres Pavilion" Thank you to Aaron Violi, Cindy McLeish, Jim Child and Fiona McAllister for showing your sincere interest in opening the Beryl Ayres pavilion and your kind words about Beryl who is not only a sporting legend but a beautiful, gentle human bean, and to all the people who turned up on the day to join in the celebrations, a big thank you. It means a lot to The Healesville Bowling Club, and of course Beryl, who wonders "What's all the fuss about" and to her son Robert who thinks the world of his mother and is forever grateful for naming the Pavilion after her.
